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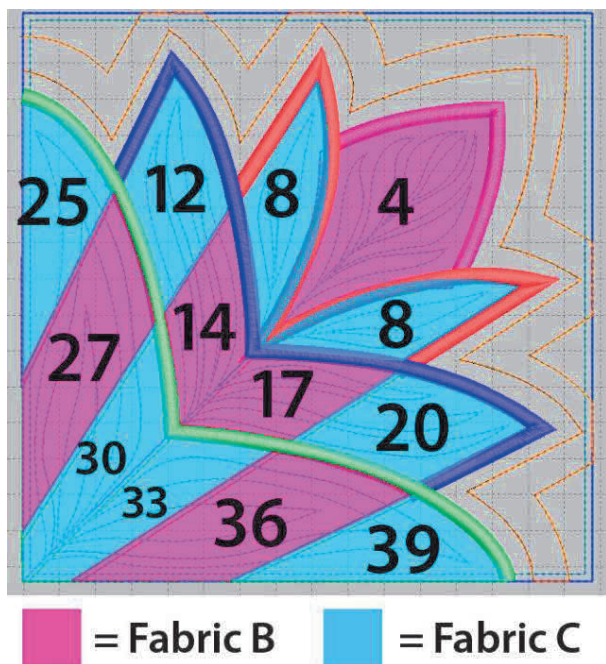

Cleopatra's Fan Quilt and Blocks 4x4 5x5 6x6 and 7x7 instructions

The Cleopatra's Fan Quilt comes with the main fan block, border blocks and corner blocks.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Use the following diagram for the fabric requirements:



4x4 hoop – 10cm x 10cm

FAN BLOCK

Fabric A – cut 1 x 16cm x 16cm (6" x 6") background

Fabric B1 – cut 1 x 6cm x 6cm (2.5" x 2.5") Piece 4 (refer to diagram)

Fabric B2 – cut 2 x 4cm x 5cm (1.5" x 2") Pieces 14 and 17 (refer to diagram)

Fabric B3 – cut 2 x 5cm x 8cm (2" x 3") Pieces 27 and 36 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C1 – cut 1 x 8cm x 9cm (3" x 3.5") Piece 8 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C2 – cut 2 x 5cm x 6cm (2" x 2.5") Pieces 12 and 20 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C3 – cut 2 x 5cm x 6cm (2" x 2.5") Pieces 25 and 39 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C4 – cut 2 x 4cm x 6cm (1.5" x 2.5") Pieces 30 and 33 (refer to diagram)

Batting 1 16cm x 16cm (6" x 6")

BORDER BLOCK (MAKES ONLY 1)

Fabric A – cut 1 x 8cm x 16cm (3" x 6") background

Fabric B – cut 1 x 6cm x 6cm (2.5" x 2.5") Middle flower

Fabric C – cut 1 x 8cm x 16cm (3" x 6") Leaves

Fabric D – cut 1 x 4cm x 4cm (1.5" x 1.5") Inner part of the flower

Batting 1 8cm x 16cm (3" x 6")

CORNER BLOCK (MAKES ONLY 1)

Fabric A – cut 1 x 9cm x 9cm (3.5" x 3.5") background

Fabric B – cut 1 x 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") Middle flower

Fabric C – cut 1 x 6cm x 6cm (2.5" x 2.5") Leaves

Batting 1 9cm x 19cm (3.5" x 3.5")

5x5 hoop – 13cm x 13cm

FAN BLOCK

Fabric A – cut 1 x 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") background

Fabric B1 – cut 1 x 9cm x 9cm (3.5" x 3.5") Piece 4 (refer to diagram)

Fabric B2 – cut 2 x 6cm x 9cm (2.5" x 3.5") Pieces 14 and 17 (refer to diagram)

Fabric B3 – cut 2 x 4cm x 10cm (1.5" x 4") Pieces 27 and 36 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C1 – cut 1 x 10cm x 10cm (4" x 4") Piece 8 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C2 – cut 2 x 6cm x 8cm (2.5" x 3") Pieces 12 and 20 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C3 – cut 2 x 6cm x 8cm (2.5" x 3") Pieces 25 and 39 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C4 – cut 2 x 5cm x 10cm (2" x 4") Pieces 30 and 33 (refer to diagram)

Batting 1 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7")

BORDER BLOCK (MAKES 2)

Fabric A – cut 1 x 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") background

Fabric B – cut 2 x 8cm x 8cm (3" x 3") Middle flower

Fabric C – cut 1 x 8cm x 18cm (3" x 7") Leaves

Fabric D – cut 1 x 4cm x 7cm (1.5" x 2") Inner part of the flower

Batting 1 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7")

CORNER BLOCK (MAKES 4)

Fabric A – cut 1 x 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7") background

Fabric B – cut 4 x 7cm x 7cm (2" x 2") Middle flower

Fabric C – cut 4 x 8cm x 8cm (3" x 3") Leaves

Batting 1 18cm x 18cm (7" x 7")

6x6 hoop – 16cm x 16cm

FAN BLOCK

Fabric A – cut 1 x 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") Background

Fabric B1 – cut 1 x 9cm x 13cm (3.5" x 5") Piece 4 (refer to diagram)

Fabric B2 – cut 2 x 8cm x 6cm (3" x 3.5") Pieces 14 and 17 (refer to diagram)

Fabric B3 – cut 2 x 9cm x 13cm (3.5" x 5") Pieces 27 and 36 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C1 – cut 1 x 10cm x 11cm (4" x 4.5") Piece 8 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C2 – cut 2 x 8cm x 8cm (3" x 3") Pieces 12 and 20 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C3 – cut 2 x 8cm x 8cm (4" x 2") Pieces 25 and 39 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C4 – cut 2 x 5cm x 10cm (2" x 4") Pieces 30 and 33 (refer to diagram)

Batting 1 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8")

BORDER BLOCK (MAKES 2)

Fabric A – cut 1 x 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") Background

Fabric B – cut 2 x 9cm x 9cm (3.5" x 3.5") Middle flower

Fabric C – cut 1 x 20cm x 9cm (8" x 3.5") Leaves

Fabric D – cut 1 x 4cm x 5cm (1.5" x 2") Inner part of the flower

Batting 1 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8")

CORNER BLOCK (MAKES 4)

Fabric A – cut 1 x 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8") Background

Fabric B – cut 4 x 7cm x 7cm (2.5" x 2.5") Middle flower

Fabric C – cut 4 x 8cm x 8cm (3" x 3") Leaves

Batting 1 20cm x 20cm (8" x 8")

7x7 hoop – 18cm x 18cm

FAN BLOCK

Fabric A – cut 1 x 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") background

Fabric B1 – cut 1 x 13cm x 13cm (5" x 5") Piece 4 (refer to diagram)

Fabric B2 – cut 2 x 9cm x 10cm (3.5" x 4") Pieces 14 and 17 (refer to diagram)

Fabric B3 – cut 2 x 9cm x 15cm (3.5" x 6") Pieces 27 and 36 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C1 – cut 1 x 14cm x 14cm (5.5" x 5.5") Piece 8 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C2 – cut 2 x 9cm x 10cm (3.5" x 4") Pieces 12 and 20 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C3 – cut 2 x 10cm x 13cm (4" x 5") Pieces 25 and 39 (refer to diagram)

Fabric C4 – cut 2 x 6cm x 13cm (2.5" x 5") Pieces 30 and 33 (refer to diagram)

Batting 1 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9")

BORDER BLOCK (MAKES 2)

Fabric A – cut 1 x 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") background

Fabric B – cut 3 x 10cm x 10cm (4" x 4") Middle flower

Fabric C – cut 1 x 10cm x 23cm (4" x 9") Leaves

Fabric D – cut 1 x 5cm x 6cm (2" x 2.5") Inner part of the flower

Batting 1 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9")

CORNER BLOCK (MAKES 4)

Fabric A – cut 1 x 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9") background

Fabric B – cut 4 x 7cm x 7cm (2.5" x 2.5") Middle flower

Fabric C – cut 4 x 8cm x 8cm (3" x 3") Leaves

Batting 1 23cm x 23cm (9" x 9")

Working out Fabric requirements

Blocks - Work out how many blocks you are having in your quilt. Then multiply it by how much background fabric is required for your size block.

Borders –

If you would like borders first of all decide how wide you would like them (we made them 10cm (4") wide. Measure one side of the quilt.

Cut two strips of border fabric this length.

Cut two pieces of batting to match.

Now measure one of the alternate sides (including the new border width x 2 in your measurement)

Cut two strips of border fabric this length x your width.

Cut two pieces of batting to match.

Backing – the size will depend on how big you intend to make your quilt.

To calculate use your hoop size and multiply that by the number of blocks you are having. Add the width of your borders to the length and the width of the quilt.

Binding - Measure the finished length and width of the quilt (including borders) and add them together and multiply by two. The width is optional but I usually find 8cm wide (3") wide sufficient.
